

VIDALIA PORT COMMISSION



LOCATION – Located on U.S. Highway 131 approximately 2.5 miles south of the City of Vidalia, adjacent to the Vidalia Industrial Park and 2 miles from the Concordia Parish Airport. The Vidalia Port is an emerging shallow draft port. There are currently no structures or improvements on site. The port is part of a 240 acre industrial park.

ORGANIZATION – The Vidalia Port Commission was created by Act No. 10 of the 1981 extraordinary session of the Louisiana Legislature. It is governed by board of commissioners consisting of 5 members who serve for a 2-year term. This is an emerging port.
