

VIDALIA PORT COMMISSION



LOCATION – The Port of Vidalia is situated on the banks of the Mississippi River within the Vidalia Industrial Park. Located along LA Highway 131, approximately 2.5 miles south of the City of Vidalia and US Highway 84, 2 miles from Concordia Parish Airport and 6 miles from Natchez Railway at Mississippi River Milepost 359 AHP. The Port of Vidalia is currently under construction and is an emerging shallow draft port.

ORGANIZATION – The Vidalia Port Commission was created by Act No. 10 of the 1981 extraordinary session of the Louisiana Legislature. It is governed by a board of commissioners consisting of 7 members who serve a 4-year term.
